Lunchtime Supervision

A few parents have asked how incidents are dealt with at lunchtimes so I would like to take this opportunity to explain our procedures. If an incident occurs at lunch no matter how small or trivial it is written up if observed by an adult or communicated to an adult by a child. Mrs Skilbeck our lunchtime supervisor then deals with the incident and has a discussion with the child and communicates the incident to the class teacher. If the incident is deemed serious or it is a re-occurrence by a child then the issue is dealt with by Mrs Chernenko who is a member of our Senior Leadership Team and our Behaviour Leader. This could result in parents being informed and an alert from her to lunchtime staff to be extra vigilant. We do treat all incidents seriously but we are very lucky as our children are very well behaved and treat each other with respect
