

FS2 Maths Show and Share (February 2019) Parent questionnaire analysis

100% of the parents that attended said they found the session useful.

The parents said that the following worked well in the session:

- Useful to see what the children are learning and the links to Mathletics.
- Good to see how the children interact in school and their confidence.
- Able to understand the methods used to teach Maths.
- Parental involvement in the learning in school.
- Chance to apply the methods with my child 1:1.
- Nice to see the children in collective worship.
- Interesting to see the different ways of teaching Maths. Eg. Using playdough for subtraction.
- Simple way that the concepts were explained.
- Lots of detail given by Miss Collier.

Parents who attended the session said that the session had given them ideas about how to support their child at home.

What would you change about the session?

100% of the comments were positive. Some parents did not put any comment in this section, simply putting a line. Some parents asked for handouts and resources to use at home and use with wider family. Other comments were:

- Nothing- I really enjoyed it. Just the right amount of time. Lots of resources and ideas.
- I don't think very much. It was very well planned and organized.
- Extra 5mins longer as we didn't get chance to go to the outdoor activities.
- Make links to Mathletics.
