


Autumn 1 Homework Grid – Year 6

Here is the optional homework grid for autumn 1. These are optional tasks for your child to complete at home throughout this half term. Please encourage your child to bring in any homework tasks they complete.

<p>Make a 3d map of the UK and name/locate cities and landmarks of your choice.</p> 	<p>Use the digit cards 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 and make a 3 digit by 2 digit multiplication. Aim to get an answer as close to 20,000 as you can.</p> <p>Example: $345 \times 26 = 8970$</p> <p>(It's a long way from 20,000 so how can I change the calculation to get a higher value answer?)</p>	<p>Create a poster about the water cycle. Make sure you include all the key vocabulary and each stage of the cycle.</p> 
<p>Research and learn about St Therese of Lisieux.</p> <p>Who is she? Why is she a Saint? What can she teach us about the way we behave and God's kingdom?</p> 	<p>Learn about all the different types of triangles there are. What do they have in common? What is different? Make sure you can describe their properties including information about angles too.</p> 	<p>Read a classic novel. Write a book review about the book and include information about the main characters and a brief synopsis of the story without giving anything away!</p> <p>Take one from the classroom shelf – we have lots of lovely new ones!</p>
