Research on the internet or in your Bibles some of the stories we are learning in class. Create a cartoon strip to retell the stories.

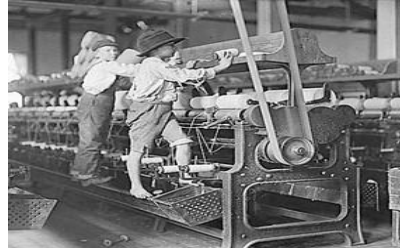

Writing

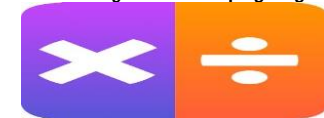
Research what it was like during the Victorian times. When you have completed your research, write a diary entry imagining you are a Victorian child. Tell us what it was like!
