We would like to produce a book, collectively as a school community, entitled:

'Lessons in lockdown. Reflections by pupils of St Joseph's Catholic Primary School, Wetherby'.

**But to do this we need your input! You are invited to submit one of the following:**

- a short poem
- a short story
- a diary entry
- a picture
- a descriptive piece
- a favourite recipe
- most interesting thing/fact you have learnt during lockdown

Your interpretation of the title theme can be as open as you choose. It could for example be your thoughts on learning at home, a descriptive piece about a new hobby or a new skill you have learnt, or a poem about family. Something new you have discovered locally (you could draw a map of a new walk or bike ride). It could be something you have learnt about yourself, or a new recipe you have perfected! Anything that reflects 'learning in lockdown' for you! Every piece of work submitted will be included in the book.



**There will be a small prize for best entry for each of the following groups:  
Early Years, KS1 and KS2.**



To add to this project, our local bookshop has said they would love to stock copies of the final book, so not only will you have your work printed in a book, it will also be stocked in a high street store!

The final print will also be for sale to raise funds for the school! After the competition closes, we will be in touch with more details!

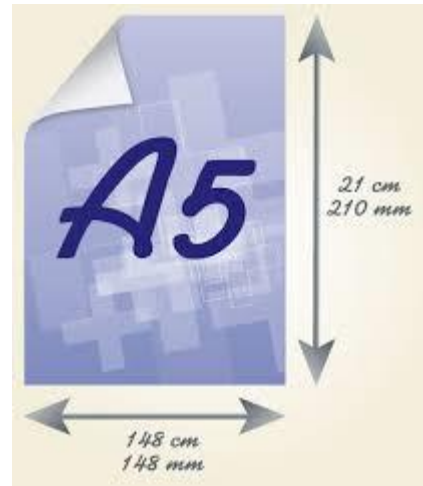
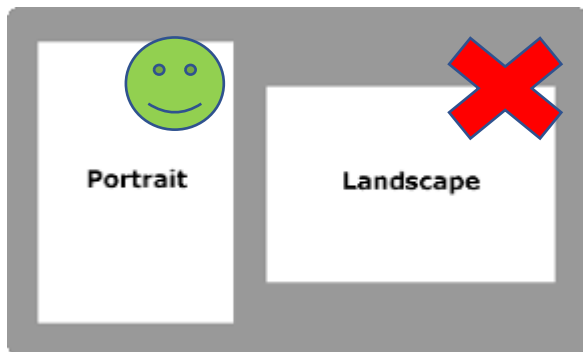


In addition, you are also invited to submit a design for the front cover! (You must submit a piece for the book also in order to enter this competition.) The winning design will feature on the front of the book and the winning pupil will receive a **£20 book token!**

Your submission check list:

- ✓ Name and class must be included on submission.
- ✓ No more than a 250 word count/ or 1,120 characters including spaces. (Including title, name and class).
- ✓ If submitting an image or you would like your text printed just as you have written it (rather than typed up), the final design must be **NO LARGER** than A5 and must be **PORTRAIT**. This image will only be reproduced in **greyscale** (to keep production costs down).
- ✓ If submitting an entry for the **book cover competition**, the final design must be **NO LARGER** than A5 and must be **PORTRAIT**. This image will be reproduced in **colour**. Please include your name and class on the back of the design or file.

**Please note:** final reproduction of all works in the book may be subject to minimal reformatting/sizing to accommodate layout.
